

How to buy shares in your Bendigo Bank Community Bank Branch

Complete a Register Your Interest form

This form is located on the Bendigo Bank website for your Community Bank Branch. Go to www.bendigobank.com.au and search for your branch. Go to the "Trading Shares (LVM)" menu. Click "Register Your Interest" and follow the prompts. Send your completed form to the address located on the "Register Your Interest" page.

Your will be sent correspondence advising of your registration ID number as well as any counterparty information.

Negotiate your Share Trade

Once you have been sent your ID number you may also be provided with counterparty information. These counterparties are interested in selling shares in the Community Bank Branch that you are interested in buying shares in. You can contact these parties to negotiate a trade of shares. For information on the value of the shares you can view the most recent share trades on the Bendigo Bank website for the branch on the "Trade History" page.

Complete a Share Purchase form

Once you have negotiated a trade with a seller you must complete a Share Purchase form and send it to the Company Secretary. The Share Purchase form is located on the Bendigo Bank website for your Community Bank Branch. Go to www.bendigobank.com.au and search for your branch. Go to the "Trading Shares (LVM)" menu. Click "Register Your Interest" and scroll to the bottom of the page. Under "Hardcopy forms" you will see a Share Purchase form. Send your completed form to the address located on the "Register Your Interest" page.

DO NOT arrange settlement of the share trade until you have received Board approval.

Once your form has been received the Board will review the purchase and either approve or decline. You will be notified of the decision.

Arrange settlement of the trade

Once the Board has approved the trade you can arrange settlement with the seller. The seller must surrender their Share Certificate to you when you provide payment for the shares. A Security Transfer Form must also be completed by both parties. The Security Transfer form is located on the Bendigo Bank website for your Community Bank Branch.

Go to www.bendigobank.com.au and search for your branch. Go to the "Trading Shares (LVM)" menu. Click "Register Your Interest" and scroll to the bottom of the page. Under "Hardcopy Forms" you will see a Security Transfer form. Send your completed form to the address located on the "Register Your Interest" page along with the Share Certificate that was surrendered by the seller.

Once the forms have been completed and received you will be issued with a new Share Certificate.
